#### ABSOLUTION



It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green.


It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit."

<sup>23</sup>"Rejoice in that day and leap for joy, because great is your reward in heaven. For that is how their ancestors treated the prophets.


