SECOND LESSON: 1 Corinthians 3:5-11

⁵ What, after all, is Apollos? And what is Paul? Only servants, through whom you came to believe—as the Lord has assigned to each his task. ⁶ I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow. ⁷ So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow. ⁸ The one who plants and the one who waters have one purpose, and they will each be rewarded according to their own labor. ⁹ For we are co-workers in God's service; you are God's field, God's building.

¹⁰ By the grace God has given me, I laid a foundation as a wise builder, and someone else is building on it. But each one should build with care. ¹¹ For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.

GOSPEL: Matthew 13:1-9,18-23

After the announcement of the Gospel, the congregation speaks:

C: Glory be to you, O Lord!

That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat by the lake. ² Such large crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat in it, while all the people stood on the shore. ³ Then he told them many things in parables, saying: "A farmer went out to sow his seed. ⁴ As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. ⁵ Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. ⁶ But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. ⁷ Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants. ⁸ Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown. ⁹ Whoever has ears, let them hear."

¹⁸ "Listen then to what the parable of the sower means: ¹⁹ When anyone hears the message about the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in their heart. This is the seed sown along the path. ²⁰ The seed falling on rocky ground refers to someone who hears the word and at once receives it with joy. ²¹ But since they have no root, they last only a short time. When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, they quickly fall away. ²² The seed falling among the thorns refers to someone who hears the word, but the worries of this life and the deceitfulness of wealth choke the word, making it unfruitful. ²³ But the seed falling on good soil refers to someone who hears the word and understands it. This is the one who produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown."

M: This is the Gospel of the Lord.

C: Praise be to you, O Christ!

"Notice is hereby given that there will be a special voter's meeting of the congregation of Shepherd of the Lakes Evangelical Lutheran Church, Martin County, Minnesota, a religious corporation, on the 2nd day of August, 2020, at 11:30 am., or as soon thereafter as may be convened. Following our service, we will hold our special voters meeting for the sale of the church property. Right after that meeting, we will begin our service to move to our new building.

The plan is to walk the cross and communion ware and the individual candles from the current location to our new building, where the short service will continue. The weather right now is calling for sunny and mid 80s. If you do not wish to walk but would find it more comfortable to drive, please feel free to do so! We would rather you drove instead of making yourself sick in the heat!

We will not be able to have our normal potluck. However, should you wish to bring a chair and food, we invite you to gather in our parking lot to enjoy a picnic-type meal and socialize while also being able to maintain our social distancing!

Bible Story in a Bag

Due to COVID-19, we were unable to hold our Vacation Bible School over the Summer as is the usual plan. To try and still provide some sort of religious education for our community's children, we are handing out Bible Story in a Bag. They contain a Bible story for the week along with some extra reading and biblical explanation/takeaway of that story. It also contains a STEM project for the children to enjoy which ties into the Bible story of the week. They have been handed out on Monday evenings in front of the church.

Feel free to take some of these bags yourself to hand out to anyone you think might enjoy them or benefit from them! You can find them in the back of church. Again, this is to fill in for our VBS which we were unable to provide this year. So take as many as you think you need!

COVID-19 Worship Preparedness Plan

Please take time to review our COVID-19 Worship Preparedness Plan. There have been some changes to our latest version. This especially includes our governor's latest mandate regarding the wearing of masks. Pastor will email the latest version out and also post it at both entries to the church and in other various places. Some of the main points include:

- Please stay home if you feel sick or show any symptoms of COVID-19
- Wash/sanitize hands regularly
- Face masks are mandatory (and may be removed for singing)
- Sit at least 6 feet apart by household groups (to aid in this, we have roped off certain pews to help measure six feet distances between groups)
- Please allow the ushers to hand you your worship folder so there are fewer hands than not touching multiple folders
- Continuous line communion (members will line up on the pulpit side of the sanctuary keeping 6 feet apart by household unit; household units may commune together; after receiving the bread from pastor, move to the elder to receive the wine; discard of your individual cup I the waste basket provided and return to your seat; a communal blessing will take place after everyone is seated)
- Please take home your worship folder and Bible Class handout after service
